

# How do you **STAND OUT**?

## Object lesson:

Have each one write their name on the sheet of paper all about the same size. Hang a large sheet of paper in the front of the class. (Do make sure something protects the wall behind it or that the paper is thick enough that the marker won't bleed through.)

Ask for 4 volunteers. Give one a pencil, one a regular pen, one a black crayon, and one a Sharpie permanent marker.



Have them stand back and look at their names. Which one stands out more than the others? Which one do they think will last the longest if the paper were hung out in the rain?

Challenge students to live their lives to stand out from the rest of the crowd, to make a permanent, positive mark on the world around them by having good character.

Persons with good character show by their actions that they stand out from those around them.

## DISCUSSION:

- How can we stand out as a good person?
- Is a good person, someone to look up to and admire? Does that make us stand out from others?
- Do people stand out if they set a good example for everyone? Why?
- How do we know the difference between right and wrong, so that we do the right thing?
- How can we make the world a better place by “standing out”?
